

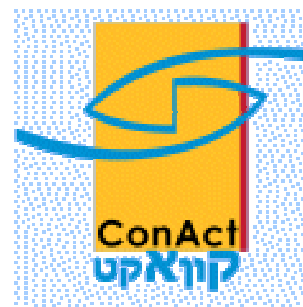

Qualification in volunteer-management –
**German-Israeli seminar for professionals
in youth work and volunteer guidance**
03. – 08. October 2007, Berlin

Voluntary engagement of youngsters and citizens of all ages is a topic of high interest both in the German and Israeli society. Numerous communal services and public activities in our civil societies are being supported and often only realised by the help of volunteering people of all ages. In order to make good use of this personal voluntary engagement in all kinds of projects it needs good qualification of the responsible leaders:

- What are suitable ways of finding and recruiting volunteers?
- How do volunteers need to be guided and accompanied in their voluntary work in order to be satisfied personally and to be of real help for the project?
- What does a good cooperation of voluntary and professional workers need, to be efficient for the named field of activities?
- How are volunteers being rewarded for their commitment?

These among other questions shall be dealt with during a five days bilateral seminar & workshop in Berlin, bringing together involved and responsible professionals in the field of voluntary work from Israel and Germany in order to learn from one another and to share bilateral training sessions.

The seminar is a project of ConAct – Coordination Center German-Israeli Youth Exchange and the Israel Youth Exchange Council, in cooperation with The Academy for Volunteering Germany and the Israeli Association for Youth Voluntarism.

Simultaneous translation German-Hebrew will be provided throughout the seminar, especially in plenary sessions. Yet, good abilities to communicate in English are requested for the workshops.

Collective seminar end: Saturday, 6. October 2007, evening

Optional: Sunday, 7. October 2007 - programme day in Berlin for Israeli participants; German participants are invited to take part in the day.

Participation fee:

Israeli Participants pay about 25% of their flight ticket, adding to the subsidised costs of the flight, and a participation fee of \$ 100,-. The certain amount depends on the price of the flight ticket and is not clear by now.

German Participants pay € 100,-; travel costs to Berlin are granted, according to second class of Deutsche Bahn.

Registration is possible by filling out the registration form, **latest until 7th September 2007 for German participants and until 24th August 2007 for Israeli participants.**
